MONTHLY WEATHER REPORT

THE WEATHER IN AUGUST 2010

General Weather Conditions: In August the weather was warm and dry. The mean air temperature was about 3 °C above normal while the area average precipitation was zero.

<u>Abnormal weather Conditions</u>: On the 1st of the month, Athalassa Station recorded a maximum temperature of 45.6 °C, which was 8.4 °C above normal, and a minimum temperature of 29.0 °C, which was 7 °C above normal. The maximum temperature of 45.6 °C recorded on the 1st of August 2010 is the highest temperature ever recorded in Cyprus since the beginning of the previous century.

Also, during the month, long periods with temperatures above 40 °C where recorded.

<u>Precipitation</u>: According to preliminary estimates the area average precipitation in August was 0 mm i.e. 0% of normal. Monthly precipitation was zero in all areas.

The cumulative area average precipitation during the period October 2009-August 2010 was about 545.4mm, i.e. 109% of normal. The cumulative precipitation was above or around normal in all areas except in some mountainous and semi-mountainous areas.

Temperature: The mean air temperature for the month was about 3 °C above normal. Mean daily temperatures were above or around normal during the whole of the month. Extremely high temperatures were recorded during the periods 1-3 and 15-29 of the month, when maximum and minimum temperatures were about 2 to 8 °C above normal. Maximum temperatures exceeded 40° C at Athalassa on 12 occasions, 35 °C at Larnaka Airport on 14 and at Prodromos they exceeded 30° C on 19 occasions. Most stations recorded their highest maximum temperature either during the period 1-2 or on the 22nd of the month and their lowest minimum temperature either on the 8th or on the 20th or during the period 28-31 of the month.

The 5-day averages of air temperature and their differences from normal at various places are shown in Table 1 and the extreme temperatures are shown in Table 2.
