7. The holder of the Prospecting Permit or a Mining Lease or Quarry Licence puts a money guarantee which is proportional to the size of the area covered by the permit, the lease or the licence and to the cost needed for the restoration of any impact on the environment.

8. For the state land which is covered by any Mining Lease or Quarry Licence, the lessee and the licensee shall pay every year a market rent which is estimated by the Director of Lands and Survey Department. The market rent shall be re-estimated every five years period:

Until the estimation of the market rent the licensee shall pay for the state land which is covered by the Quarry Licence the amount of fifty seven euros ((€57,00) for every decar or part thereof for every year covered by the licence. This amount shall be accumulated with the market rent when the licensee is invited to pay it.
