







It has been placed under the auspices of the Department of Meteorology in order to be distributed to secondary schools as a means to raise awareness among students on climate change.

























The experts are talking about severe drought over Cyprus this year. The desalination units provide us with drinkable water, but I never thought how much damage drought can cause to the flora and fauna.






















No, this cannot happen ... Aphrodite, we must stop Viren!


Alone we are helpless...

Think of what keeps this freak alive... I'm not feeling well...I'm dying...the Rulers of the Planet... perhaps they are the only ones that may help.











































Viren is lurking... You are responsible to preserve the beauty and life on the green planet. There may never be another chance...

You've got one...last chance!

It's February, 2023 and the twins Gaius and Aphrodite are yet again visiting the Salt Lake of Larnaka.

They are awaiting the arrival of their friend, Black Flame, the one-of-a-kind black flamingo, but in vain. He should have been there since autumn. As they are about to leave, Black Flame arrives! He looks terribly exhausted.

He describes the problems that he encountered on his way to Cyprus: rise in temperature, melting of ice, consequences of war, air pollution. With the help of a magic watch he contacts the flamingo leaders in other countries and each one of them describes the problems that their countries are facing. Greece is struggling with forest fires and the ensuing threat to its flora and fauna; Italy is tackling the decline of its glaciers and severe weather phenomena; Spain is combating population movements, arable land and food scarcity, all consequences of sea level rise; Cyprus is facing drought and biodiversity loss.

Black Flame cannot recover from the hardships he's been through and at the same time Aphrodite falls ill experiencing an extremely high temperature. In order to save Black Flame and his sister, Gaius asks for help from the flamingo leader in Italy. At the root of all problems lies Viren, a hideous monster that lives in the crater of a volcano and has stolen the magic gem that maintains balance and life on Earth.

With every breath Viren grows bigger and stronger. The source of his power is everything that causes destruction to the planet: exhaust fumes, chemical and nuclear weapons, waste of natural resources, fires, ocean pollution. The bigger he grows, the warmer his breath becomes, causing the rise in temperature and all the difficulties that the flamingos encountered while migrating.

Gaius takes action to retrieve the gem that will keep Aphrodite and Black Flame alive. He appeals to the Rulers of the Planet, but they treat him disparagingly and dismissively.

However, when the greatest thunderstorm of all time breaks out, they realise that nothing matters more than saving the planet and mankind. Explicit orders are given by the Rulers of the Planet for immediate restoration; the fires are extinguished and trees are planted; the oceans are cleaned up; renewable energy is harnessed. Every one of these actions causes Viren to gradually lose his power and shrink, until he finally collapses.

The flamingo from Italy seizes the opportunity and retrieves the magic gem that will save the planet.

Meanwhile, our heroes are back at the Salt Lake in Cyprus. Black Flame begins to recover, but unfortunately this is not the case for Aphrodite. She is burning up and slowly dying.

Just as she is saying goodbye to her brother and closes her eyes, the Italian flamingo leader arrives holding the magic gem; he approaches Aphrodite and once he places the gem on her chest, she disappears!

A few months later Gaius and Black Flame are enjoying the now verdant Salt Lake in Cyprus.

Black Flame's watch rings, Aphrodite is calling! She is on planet Venus enjoying the high temperatures! Its greenhouse gases inspire her to engage in greenhouse cultivation, since there is no other lifeform there. The only thing that bothers her is the "dense" atmosphere!

She advises Gaius to take care of his own planet, Earth, perhaps the most beautiful planet in the whole universe. He must always be vigilant, as Viren is lurking and may threaten them again at any time...

Symbolisms:

The selection of our heroes was not accidental by any means!

Gaius and Aphrodite symbolise the twin planets of our solar system, Earth and Venus ("Gaia" in Greek means Earth and planet Venus is called Aphrodite!). In contrast to Earth, there is no life on Venus due to the extremely high temperature of around 460°C. This is attributed to the small distance between Venus and the Sun, the high concentration of greenhouse gases and the high atmospheric pressure.

If no measures are taken to reverse climate change, Earth's future might look very similar to the conditions on Venus. Aphrodite was magically removed from the life-threatening situation she was facing, like a modern-day Iphigenia in Tauris. According to Greek mythology the goddess of beauty was born in Cyprus and she is directly related to the myths and folk tales of our country.

Black Flame is no other than the black flamingo that annually visits Larnaka Salt Lake for the past few years! The word "flamingo" is Spanish and means the one who has the colour of the flame. Thus, we named our hero "Black Flame", since he had to deal with the burning issue of the climate crisis.

Flamingos are migratory birds and travel from northern European countries to Africa. They are a protected species and one of the most distinctive in the wetlands of Cyprus. Therefore, we drew inspiration from their migration journey to convey the catastrophic consequences of climate change.

We chose to send our flying messengers to the four countries with which we collaborate within the framework of the ClimART project! Italy, Greece, Spain and Cyprus! We tried to depict the most severe problems each country is facing due to the climate crisis.
