



- □ 27 863 sites

→ Conclusions in December 2016:


The Nature Directives are fit for purpose...

Action Plan for Nature, People and the Economy

- Response of the Commission to the Fitness check of nature legislation
- Adopted 27 April 2017
- 4 priority areas and 15 concrete actions



A: Improving guidance and knowledge and ensuring better coherence with broader socio-economic objectives

B: Building political ownership and strengthening compliance

C: Strengthening investment in N2000 and improving synergies with EU funding instruments

D: Better communication and outreach, engaging citizens, stakeholders and communities




Action 1: Update, develop and actively promote, in all EU languages, guidance on:


(a) site permitting procedures, species protection and management as well as sector-specific guidance























B) Specific project: Reviewing and mitigating the impacts of renewable energy developments on habitats and species protected under the Birds and Habitats Directives

- European Parliament funds
- 2 years (Dec 2017 Dec 2019)
- Aim: understand better the impacts of renewable energy on protected species and habitats (mainly birds, bats, marine mammals)
- Covers all forms of renewable energy (excepted hydropower and transmission infrastructure)
- Contractors: Arcadis (IEEP, NIRAS, Ecosystems Ltd, Birdlife Europe, Stella consulting, Expert on marine mammals)



Aims of the project

- Provide guidance to Member States and stakeholders for the specific sector/sub-sectors
- Update the 2011 guidance on wind energy and Natura 2000
- Help Member States in overcoming obstacles related to permitting procedures
